

TEXAS LOW-LEVEL RADIOACTIVE WASTE DISPOSAL COMPACT COMMISSION

Order Authorizing the Export of Waste for

Houston Northwest Medical Center


On or about March 30, 2011, the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Compact Commission ("Commission") received from Houston Northwest Medical Center a Petition to Export Class A Low-Level Radioactive Waste for Permanent Disposal ("Petition") in the Energy Solutions site, located near Oak Ridge, Tennessee. The Petition was filed pursuant to Section 3.05(7) of the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Compact and the Commission resolution dated December 11, 2009, authorizing consideration of such export petitions.

By a majority vote of those present, at the Commission's meeting posted for August 20, 2011, a majority of the members of the Commission approved the Petition filed by Houston Northwest Medical Center on the terms stated in the Petition, subject only to the following terms and conditions:

1. Houston Northwest Medical Center will supply to the Commission:
 - a. Manifests and/or reports of volume, mass, and activity sent for ultimate disposal which are satisfactory to the Commission.
 - b. Final reconciliation of waste volume concluded not later than 180 days post Order period.
2. The Period of the shipment of the waste from the site of generation is authorized as effective from October 2009 until such time as the Compact Waste Facility is open and is accepting waste for disposal.

It is hereby ordered that Houston Northwest Medical Center is authorized to export low-level radioactive waste as requested in the Petition, subject to the terms and condition as stated in this Order. The Petition is attached to this Order.

6. Total Waste Volume: < 1 cubic foot

7. Description of Waste: Dry, active solid waste with 0.5 μ Ci of Gd-153 and 0.5 μ Ci of Sr-90

8. Reason that the Petition should be granted:

This material was transported from Houston Northwest Medical Center in October, 2009, prior to the January 15, 2010 memo from the TLLRWDC to all low-level radioactive waste generators in Texas informing them of the requirement to obtain export authorization. The permit is needed to comply with State of Utah regulatory requirements.

9. Certifications:

- I hereby certify that the Petitioner is licensed (for radioactive materials) and/or permitted (for hazardous waste), if applicable, and agrees to receive back the waste if its management or disposal is not allowed at the proposed disposal facility.
- I hereby certify that to the best of my knowledge the information provided herein is accurate and correct and that the LLRW for which this Export Petition is submitted will be packaged and shipped in accordance with

applicable state and federal regulations and is acceptable for disposal at the intended disposal facility.
