

TEXAS LOW-LEVEL RADIOACTIVE WASTE DISPOSAL COMPACT COMMISSION

Order Authorizing the Export of Waste for

Lockheed Martin


On or about November 5, 2010, the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Compact Commission ("Commission") received from Philotechnics on behalf of Lockheed Martin a Petition to Export Class A Low-Level Radioactive Waste for Permanent Disposal ("Petition") in the US Ecology facility located near Grandview, Idaho. The Petition was filed pursuant to Section 3.05(7) of the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Compact and the Commission resolution dated December 11, 2009, authorizing consideration of such export petitions.

By a 7 to 0 vote of those present, with 1 absent, at the Commission's meeting posted for January 4, 2011, majority of the members of the Commission approved the Petition filed by Philotechnics on behalf of Lockheed Martin on the terms stated in the Petition, subject only to the following terms and conditions:

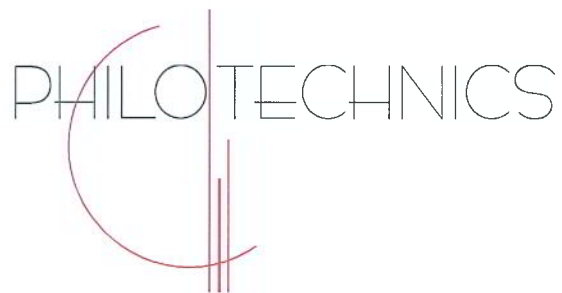
1. Lockheed Martin will supply to the Commission:
 - a. Manifests and/or reports of volume, mass, and activity sent for ultimate disposal which are satisfactory to the Commission.
 - b. Final reconciliation of waste volume concluded not later than 180 days post Order period.
2. The Period of the shipment of the waste from the site of generation is authorized as effective from January 4, 2011, until such time as the Compact Waste Facility is open and is accepting waste for disposal.

It is hereby ordered that Lockheed Martin is authorized to export low-level radioactive waste as requested in the Petition, subject to the terms and condition as stated in this Order. The Petition is attached to this Order.

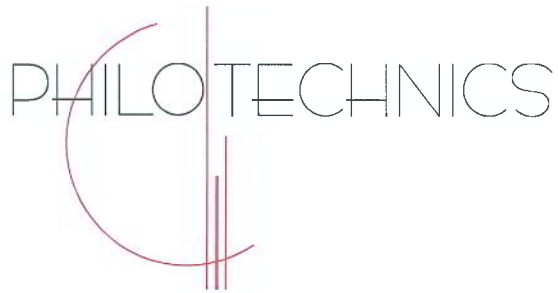


