

TEXAS LOW-LEVEL RADIOACTIVE WASTE DISPOSAL COMPACT COMMISSION

Order Authorizing the Export of Waste for STP Nuclear Operating Company


On or about October 26, 2011, the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Compact Commission ("Commission") received from STP Nuclear Operating Company a Petition to Export Class A Low-Level Radioactive Waste for Permanent Disposal ("Petition") in the EnergySolutions facility, located near Clive, Utah. The Petition was filed pursuant to Section 3.05(7) of the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Compact and the Commission resolution dated December 11, 2009, authorizing consideration of such export petitions.

By a majority vote of those present with one voting nay, at the Commission's meeting posted for November 9, 2011, a majority of the members of the Commission approved the Petition filed by STP Nuclear Operating Company, on the terms stated in the Petition, subject only to the following terms and conditions:

1. STP Nuclear Operating Company will supply to the Commission:
 - a. Manifests and/or reports of volume, mass, and activity sent for ultimate disposal which are satisfactory to the Commission.
 - b. Final reconciliation of waste volume concluded not later than 180 days post Order period.
2. The Period of the shipment of the waste from the site of generation is authorized as effective from November 9, 2011, until May 9, 2012.

It is hereby ordered that STP Nuclear Operating Company is authorized to export low-level radioactive waste as requested in the Petition, subject to the terms and condition as stated in this Order. The Petition is attached to this Order.
