Order Authorizing the Export of Waste

Southwest Research Institute®

On 30 November 2009 the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Compact Commission (“Commission”) received from Southwest Research Institute® (SwRI®) a Petition to Export Class A Low-Level Radioactive Waste for Treatment and Permanent Disposal (“Petition”) in the following facilities:

Clive, UT


The Petition was filed pursuant to Section 3.05(7) of the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Compact and the Resolution to Consider Export Petitions Pursuant to Texas Compact (P.L. 105-236) Section 3.05(7), which was adopted by the Commission at its 21 July 2009 meeting.

By a unanimous vote of those present, with one absent, at the Commission’s meeting posted for 10 – 11 December 2009, a majority of the members of the Commission approved the Petition filed by SwRI on the terms stated in the Petition, subject only to the following terms and conditions:

1. SwRI will supply to the Commission:
 - a. Manifests and/or reports of volume, mass, and activity sent for processing and ultimate disposal which are satisfactory to the Commission.
 - b. Final reconciliation of waste volume concluded not later than 180 days post Order period.
2. The Period of the shipment of the waste from the site of generation is authorized as effective from the date as submitted in the petition shall expire at the end of the day on 30 September 2010.
3. Granting of this Order does not preclude the Commission’s consideration of the imposition of export fees at a future date, which fees might be applicable to the export of waste under this order.

It is hereby ordered that Southwest Research Institute® is authorized to export low-level radioactive waste as requested in the Petition, subject to the terms and condition as stated in this Order. The Petition is attached to this Order.
