Dear Ms. Ing:

Pursuant to our phone conversation, Studsvik is submitting an amendment to its Import Agreement 2-0009-00 with the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Compact Commission. The purpose of the amendment is to update the activity for C-14 and Tc-99. The reason for the request is that some Studsvik customers shipped waste that differed notably from the originally expected and historical waste. Studsvik is not requesting an increase in either total Curies or volume.

Studsvik seeks to increase its C-14 allocation by 1,190 mCi. This amends Article II.K.(g)(1) to be: "C-14 31,190 millicuries (mCl)".

Studsvik seeks to increase its Tc-99 allocation by 49,335 μ Ci. This amends Article II.K.(g)(2) to be: "Tc-99 830,33 microcuries (μ CI)".

The following table summarizes the key aspects of Agreement 2-0009-00, the requested amendment, and the updated totals.
