

Petition to Export Low-Level Radioactive Waste

1. Petitioner: Bionomics, Inc. of behalf of:

3. Proposed out of Compact Disposal Facility:

Waste will be incinerated at the Energy Solutions facility in Oak Ridge, Tennessee

4. Entity who generated the waste: Peloton Therapeutics

5. Effective Period: One Year

6. Specified Amount: approximately 30-60 gallons of Aqueous Liquids

7. Description of the wastes: Aqueous Liquids

8. Reason that petition should be granted:


Client may drain dispose these liquids under the regulations but prefers to handle this waste stream through incineration. Solidification would require additional man hours resulting in increased exposure to workers. The process will increase the risk for the spread of contamination, create other wastes and increase the volume of waste disposed. The cost for disposal of this waste is more economical by incineration.

9. Certifications:
