Re: Amendment to 2-0032-01 Bionomics Import for Non-Compact Sealed Sources from Small Quantity Generators

Dear Mr. Wilson,

Bionomics would like to amend our Import Agreement # 2-0032-01 to include Depleted Uranium in the amount of 10.0 millicuries. We are performing a collection of Sealed Sources on behalf of the SCATR program and have identified a number of small check sources that likely contain the DU isotope. This is not DU shielding.

While we anticipate on sending less than one Millicurie of activity in total, we are requesting 10 Millicuries to ensure that we meet the needs of the SCATR program. This is an ongoing effort and we are discovering new sources each day.

Please amend our current agreement to include the following:

Depleted Uranium 10,000.00 Microcuries (uCi)
