**FIRST AMENDMENT**

TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN

RADIAC ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES ("RADIAC")

AND

THE TEXAS LOW-LEVEL RADIOACTIVE WASTE DISPOSAL COMPACT COMMISSION  
("COMMISSION")

SIGNED BY RADIAC ON MARCH 26, 2014

AND BY

THE COMMISSION ON MARCH 26, 2014

Article II. A. is amended to read as follows:

- A. This Agreement shall remain in effect according to its terms from March 13, 2014 through August 31, 2015 unless it is amended by agreement of the Parties, revoked, or suspended by the Commission. Generator agrees to provide to the Commission within 30 days after the end of each Facility operating year the actual cubic feet and Curies disposed of by Generator during that particular operating year. The Facility year ends on August 31.

Article II. J. (c) is amended to read as follows:

- J. (c) Place of origination (State or U.S. Territory) of waste: AL, AR, AZ, CA, CT, DE, FL, GA, IA, IL, IN, KS, KY, LA, MD, MO, MI, MS, NC, ND, NE, NH, NJ, NY, OH, OK, PA, RI, SD, TN, VA, WI or WV\*

\*Authorization to import non-party compact low-level radioactive waste as described in this Article II.J. from any of the states listed is not effective until: (i) prior to any shipment containing non-party compact waste from a state that is a member of the Southwestern Low-Level Radioactive Waste Compact and the Central Interstate Low-Level Radioactive Waste Compact Commission, Broker has delivered to the Commission written evidence satisfactory to the Commission of the approval for the export of Non-party Compact Waste from the Southwestern Low-Level Radioactive Waste Compact and the Central Interstate Low-Level Radioactive Waste Compact Commission; (ii) prior to shipment, Broker has delivered to the Commission written evidence satisfactory to the Commission that it has received authorization from each generator for the disposal of the generator's waste in the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Compact facility; and (iii) Broker has received a written communication from the Commission stating the written evidence of export authorization and generator authorization is in a form satisfactory to the Commission. All evidence delivered to the Commission in support of this Agreement shall be provided in no more than five information packages.

No other provision of the agreement between RADIAC and the Commission is affected by this First Amendment. This Amendment is effective as of the date of its approval by the Commission on September 25, 2014.
