Re: Amendment to Bionomics Import Agreement #2-0074-00

Dear Mr. Hurley,

Bionomics would like to amend our Import Agreement # 2-0074-00 to include the States comprising the Rocky Mountain Compact and to include the disposal of Depleted Uranium. Our Sealed Sources collection on behalf of the SCATR program has expanded to include States which were previously not included in the current Agreement. Additionally, WCS has expanded their capabilities and can now accept DU Shielding previously not permitted for disposal.

Please amend our current agreement to add the Rocky Mountain Compact States of **Colorado, New Mexico and Nevada**. Our amended Agreement should include all States except for those in the Northwest Compact as well as Puerto Rico and the District of Columbia. Authorization will be provided to the Compact Commission from the Rocky Mountain Compact prior to shipment.

Please amend our current agreement with an increase in volumes and activity for DU waste streams. The waste will come primarily from small generators, however due to the present back logs some initial shipments may be more than 75 cubic feet from any one generator.

Depleted Uranium Waste	300 cubic feet
DU activity	3.0 curies

Under Section 3 Waste for Importation these changes;

Total Volume from 75 cubic Feet to 375 cubic feet
Total activity from 125 curies to 128 curies
Waste Form to include Stable and Unstable
Depleted Uranium from 10.0 Millicuries to 3.0 Curies
