TEXAS LOW-LEVEL RADIOACTIVE WASTE DISPOSAL COMPACT COMMISSION

Order Authorizing the Export of Waste for

STP Nuclear Operating Company

On or about October 15, 2014, the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Compact Commission ("Commission") received from **STP Nuclear Operating Company** a Petition to Export Class A low-level radioactive waste for permanent disposal ("Petition") in the EnergySolutions burial site near Clive, Utah. The Petition was filed pursuant to Section 3.05(7) of the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Compact and the Commission resolution dated December 11, 2009, authorizing consideration of such export petitions.

At the Commission's meeting posted for and held on November 13, 2014, five or more members of the Commission voted to approve the Petition filed by **STP Nuclear Operating Company**, on the terms stated in the Petition, subject only to the following terms and conditions:

1. **STP Nuclear Operating Company** will supply to the Commission:

- a. Manifests and/or reports of volume, mass, and activity sent for ultimate disposal which are satisfactory to the Commission.
- b. Final reconciliation of waste volume concluded not later than 180 days post Order period.
- 2. The Period of the shipment of the waste from the site of generation is authorized as effective from January 1, 2015 through August 31, 2015.

It is hereby ordered that **STP Nuclear Operating Company** is authorized to export low-level radioactive waste as requested in the Petition, subject to the terms and conditions stated in this Order. The Petition is attached to this Order.
