Agreement is subject to receipt by the Compact Facility Operator and the Commission of written certification from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) prior to the acceptance of Generator's Nonparty Compact Waste that the waste to be imported is authorized for disposal under the Compact Facility license. Agreed
- G. A description of the characteristics of the waste proposed for importation including (but not limited to) volume, type, physical form, total radioactivity, and radionuclide-specific activities.

The exact details on each waste shipment will not be determined until after the waste is properly packaged for disposal at the compact facility. These are Sealed Sources from small waste generators and the waste is often not fully determined until after it is picked up from each waste generator. Typically the sources include Cs-137 and Co-60 and the total activity per drum will be less than 16 curies. If an Import permit is not forthcoming there is no need to package the waste, therefore we cannot provide the exact details until after the Import Permit is issued.

Five days prior to shipment to the WCS facility Bionomics is required to submit a copy of the Radioactive Shipment Manifest to WCS, TCEQ and DSHS. This manifest contains the details of each container and would include all the information requested in Item G. This same information can be forwarded to the Commission when it is provided to TCEQ.

- H. A representation by the applicant that it has disclosed:
- The existence of unresolved violations pending against the applicant with any other (1) regulatory agency with jurisdiction to regulate radioactive material.
- (2) The existence of any unresolved violation(s), complaint(s), unpaid fee(s), or past due report(s) that the applicant has with the Commission.
- (3) The existence of any unresolved violation(s), complaint(s), unpaid fee(s), or past due reports that the applicant has with any other regulatory body, including, without limitation, the TCEO.

This is agreed to and this agreement is also included on the Import Application in Items 5 and 6.

- I. An acknowledgement that a misrepresentation with respect to an item listed in H may result in the cancellation of the agreement. Agreed
- The obligation to report immediately to the Commission any allegation of the violation of any law, rule or regulation related to the storage, shipment or treatment of any form of radioactive material. Agreed
- K. A provision acknowledging the right of the Commission to audit or cause to be audited compliance with the agreement. Agreed
- Agreement to comply to the extent applicable with the rules related to commingling L. adopted by the TCEQ in coordination with the Commission pursuant to THSC, §401.207(k).

- M. An affirmation that no waste of international origin shall ever be included in the materials to be imported to the Compact facility. Affirmed
