TEXAS LOW-LEVEL RADIOACTIVE WASTE DISPOSAL COMPACT COMMISSION

Order Authorizing the Export of Waste

Agilent Technologies

On or about May 19, 2016, the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Compact Commission ("TLLRWDCC" or "Commission") received from **Veolia ES Technical Solutions on behalf of Agilent Technologies** a Petition to Export Class A radioactive waste described as: 32 cubic feet of 1) aqueous waste containing 10% ethanol in solution with tritium, and 2) liquid scintillation vials with tritium, and 3) dry active waste with tritium. The waste will be processed at Energy Solutions near Oak Ridge, Tennessee. The Petition was filed pursuant to section 3.05(7) of the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Compact authorizing consideration of such export petitions.

At the Commission's meeting posted for and held on June 30, 2016, a majority of the members of the Commission voted to approve the Petition filed by **Veolia ES Technical Solutions on behalf of Agilent Technologies,** on the terms stated in the Petition, subject only to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. Agilent Technologies will supply to the Commission:
 - a. Manifests and /or reports of the volume, mass, and activity sent for ultimate disposal which are satisfactory to the Commission.
 - b. Final reconciliation of waste volume concluded not later than 180 days post Order period.
- 2. The Period of the shipment of waste from the site of generation is authorized through August 31, 2016.

It is hereby ordered that **Veolia ES Technical Solutions on behalf of Agilent Technologies** is authorized to export low-level radioactive waste as requested in the Petition, subject only to the terms and conditions as stated in this Order. The Petition is attached to this Order.
