
Dear Ms. Koss:

Pursuant to the condition expressed as a part of Article II.J. (c) of your Import Agreement TLLRWDC #2-0289-00 with the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Compact Commission ("TLLRWDC"), I have received your request to dispose of irradiated hardware in the following five shipments:

- On or about June 30, 2021: 60 cubic feet of waste with approx 10,000 Ci of activity
- On or about July 21, 2021: 60 cubic feet of waste with approx 11,000 Ci of activity
- On or about August 3, 2021: 60 cubic feet of waste with approx 11,000 Ci of activity
- On or about August 13, 2021: 60 cubic feet of waste with approx 12,000 Ci of activity

As of the date of this letter, there is sufficient capacity for importation during the State of Texas Fiscal Year 2021 to accommodate the shipments listed above as requested in your email dated June 23, 2021. This letter does not authorize the importation to the Compact Facility in Andrews County of any cubic feet or curies of low-level radioactive waste beyond the 64,700 curies and 300 cubic feet of waste requested.

Therefore, you are authorized as of the date of your receipt of this communication to import from Tennessee Valley Authority, Browns Ferry Nuclear Plant to the Compact Facility in Andrews County, Texas 44,000 curies and 240 cubic feet of irradiated hardware described in agreement TLLRWDC #2-0289-00. This shipment is approximately 100% of the volume and 73% of the activity specified in Article II.J. of agreement TLLRWDC #2-0289-00.
