
RE: Import Agreement TLLRWDC #2-0344-00  
Curie Release Letter #1

Dear Mr. Baskett:

Pursuant to the condition expressed as a part of Article II.J. (c) of your Import Agreement TLLRWDC #2-0344-00 with the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Compact Commission ("TLLRWDC"), I have received your request to dispose of 22,600 curies and 168 cubic feet of non-fuel reactor components (irradiated hardware) from the Fort Calhoun Power Station Unit 1 (NB).

As of the date of this letter, there is sufficient capacity for importation during the State of Texas Fiscal Year 2022-2023 to accommodate the shipments as requested in your letter dated August 1, 2022. This letter does not authorize the importation to the Compact Facility in Andrews County of any cubic feet or curies of low-level radioactive waste beyond the 22,600 curies and 168 cubic feet of irradiated hardware requested.

Therefore, you are authorized as of the date of your receipt of this communication to import from Fort Calhoun Power Station to the Compact Facility in Andrews County, Texas 22,600 curies and 168 cubic feet of irradiated hardware described in agreement TLLRWDC #2-0344-00. These shipments are approximately 38% of the volume and 60% of the activity specified in Article II.J. of agreement TLLRWDC #2-0344-00. With this letter, Energy Solutions/Omaha Public Power District, Fort Calhoun Station has approximately 112 of 280 cubic feet and 36,400 of 59,000 curies remaining to be shipped under agreement TLLRWDC #2-0344-00.
