Dear Mr. Heard:


Pursuant to the condition expressed as a part of Article II.J. (c) of your Import Agreement TLLRWDC #2-0346-00 with the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Compact Commission ("TLLRWDC"), I have received your request to dispose of irradiated hardware in the following five shipments:

- On or about October 25, 2022, a shipment containing 56.25 cubic feet of waste with approximately 6,100 curies of activity.
- On or about November 8, 2022, a shipment containing 56.25 cubic feet of waste with approximately 6,300 curies of activity.
- On or about November 21, 2022, a shipment containing 56.25 cubic feet of waste with approximately 7,800 curies of activity.
- On or about December 13, 2022, a shipment containing 56.25 cubic feet of waste with approximately 6,100 curies of activity.
- On or about January 17, 2023, a shipment containing 56.25 cubic feet of waste with approximately 6,100 curies of activity.

In your letter you requested a release for shipments in December and January. We will consider that request closer to the scheduled shipping dates. As of the date of this letter, there is sufficient capacity for importation during the State of Texas Fiscal Year to accommodate the shipment of 20,200 curies and 168.75 cubic feet as requested in your letter dated October 4, 2022. This letter does not authorize the importation to the Compact Facility in Andrews County of any cubic feet or curies of low-level radioactive waste beyond the 20,200 curies and 168.75 cubic feet of irradiated hardware requested in the first three shipments..

Therefore, you are authorized as of the date of your receipt of this communication to import from Entergy Grand Gulf Nuclear Station to the Compact Facility in Andrews County, Texas 20,200 curies and 168.75 cubic feet of irradiated hardware described in agreement TLLRWDC #2-0346-00. This shipment is approximately 22% of the volume and 13% of the activity specified in Article II.J. of agreement TLLRWDC #2-0346-00. With this letter, Entergy Grand Gulf Nuclear Station has remaining 611 of 780 cubic feet and 139,800 of 160,000 curies authorized to be shipped conditionally under agreement TLLRWDC #2-0346-00.

Please update the TLLRWDC as you send shipments and schedule for future shipments so we may update our tracking of imports under your agreement.
