Dear Mr. Heard:

Pursuant to the condition expressed as a part of Article II.J. (c) of your Import Agreement TLLRWDCC #2-0346-00 with the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Compact Commission ("TLLRWDCC"), I have received your request to dispose of irradiated hardware in the following three shipments:

- The 6th shipment is scheduled to be shipped on or about March 14, 2022, with a disposal volume 56.25 cubic feet with approximately 10,500 curies of activity.
- The 7th shipment is scheduled to be shipped on or about March 28, 2023, with a disposal volume 56.25 cubic feet with approximately 7,200 curies of activity.
- The 8th shipment is scheduled to be shipped on or about April 11, 2023, with a disposal volume 56.25 cubic feet with approximately 9,500 curies of activity.

As of the date of this letter, there is sufficient capacity for importation during the State of Texas Fiscal Year to accommodate the shipment of an additional 27,600 curies and 168.75 cubic feet as requested in your letter dated February 2, 2023. This letter does not authorize the importation to the Compact Facility in Andrews County of any cubic feet or curies of low-level radioactive waste beyond the 27,600 curies and 168.75 cubic feet of irradiated hardware requested in the first three shipments..

Therefore, you are authorized as of the date of your receipt of this communication to import from Entergy Grand Gulf Nuclear Station to the Compact Facility in Andrews County, Texas 27,600 curies and 168.75 cubic feet of irradiated hardware described in agreement TLLRWDCC #2-0346-00. This shipment is approximately 22% of the volume and 17.3% of the activity specified in Article II.J. of agreement TLLRWDCC #2-0346-00. With this letter, Entergy Grand Gulf Nuclear Station has remaining 330 of 780 cubic feet and 100,000 of 160,000 curies authorized to be shipped conditionally under agreement TLLRWDCC #2-0346-00.

Please update the TLLRWDCC as you send shipments and schedule for future shipments so we may update our tracking of imports under your agreement.
