20) A "small quantity generator" is a generator of low-level radioactive waste that generates no more than 200 **75** cubic feet or no more than 100 curies of such waste per year, and does not include **nuclear fuel cycle facilities**, nuclear power generation facilities, electric utilities, or the United States Department of Defense.
