page 17 lines 10-24

lines 12-13 state that one can fill out the form and be the generator of waste collected before April 27, 2012

but then in line 16

it states the waste has to be from Texas or Vermont to be in compact waste
so if the company is in Texas and collected waste before April 27, 2012 and is the generator the waste has to
be in compact waste since the instate company is the generator.

before April 27 , 2012 there was no in compact or out of compact waste so it can not be classified as such.
waste collected by an in Texas company was collected , in part as part of a recycle program, and was
transferred to the companies license, which makes it legally their source to evaluate.
if they deem the source not usable it is their waste to be disposed of as in compact waste.

all waste collected by a Texas company before there was in compact /out of compact waste needs to be
classified as in compact waste for several reasons, highest of which is the safe disposal of waste from Texas
companies inventories .

Agree all waste needs to be of not international origin, but in compact/out of compact waste was not classified
before April 27 2012.
