TEXAS LOW-LEVEL RADIOACTIVE WASTE DISPOSAL COMPACT COMMISSION

Order Authorizing the Export of Waste

STP Nuclear Operating Company

On or about May 5, 2016, the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Compact Commission ("TLLRWDCC" or "Commission") received from **STP Nuclear Operating Company** a Petition to Export Class A low-level radioactive waste described as 20,592 cubic feet of bulk dry active waste. Permanent disposal is proposed at the Energy Solutions burial site near Clive, Utah and/or Energy Solutions Bear Creek facility near Oak Ridge, Tennessee. The Petition was filed pursuant to section 3.05(7) of the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Compact authorizing consideration of such export petitions.

At the Commission's meeting posted for and held on June 30, 2016, a majority of the members of the Commission voted to approve the Petition filed by STP Nuclear Operating Company, on the terms stated in the Petition, subject only to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. STP Nuclear Operating Company will supply to the Commission:
 - a. Manifests and /or reports of the volume, mass, and activity sent for ultimate disposal which are satisfactory to the Commission.
 - b. Final reconciliation of waste volume concluded not later than 180 days post Order period.

2. The Period of the shipment of waste from the site of generation is authorized through August 31, 2017.

It is hereby ordered that STP Nuclear Operating Company is authorized to export low-level radioactive waste as requested in the Petition, subject only to the terms and conditions as stated in this Order. The Petition is attached to this Order.
