## TEXAS LOW-LEVEL RADIOACTIVE WASTE DISPOSAL COMPACT COMMISSION

## **Order Authorizing the Export of Waste**

## Southwest Research Institute

On or about May 6, 2016, the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Compact Commission ("TLLRWDCC" or "Commission") received from **Bionomics on behalf of Southwest Research Institute** a Petition to Export Class A mixed waste described as: 160 cubic feet of soil and solid samples contaminated with heavy metals and/or organic solutions and liquids with organic solvents and/or heavy metals either in bulk or in vials and small bottles. The waste will be processed at Perma-Fix in Florida. The Petition was filed pursuant to section 3.05(7) of the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Compact authorizing consideration of such export petitions.

At the Commission's meeting posted for and held on June 30, 2016, a majority of the members of the Commission voted to approve the Petition filed by **Bionomics on behalf of Southwest Research Institute**, on the terms stated in the Petition, subject only to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. Southwest Research Institute will supply to the Commission:
  - a. Manifests and /or reports of the volume, mass, and activity sent for ultimate disposal which are satisfactory to the Commission.
  - b. Final reconciliation of waste volume concluded not later than 180 days post Order period.
- 2. The Period of the shipment of waste from the site of generation is authorized through August 31, 2017.

It is hereby ordered that **Bionomics on behalf of Southwest Research Institute** is authorized to export low-level radioactive waste as requested in the Petition, subject only to the terms and conditions as stated in this Order. The Petition is attached to this Order.
