Dear Mr. Coleman:

Pursuant to the condition expressed as a part of Article II.J of your Import Agreement Amendment (TLLRWDCC #2-0134-00) with the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Compact Commission, I have received as an attachment to an email dated March 17, 2017 export authorization from the Southwestern Low-Level Radioactive Waste Commission. This satisfies the requirement to provide written evidence satisfactory to the Commission of the approval for the export of out-of-compact waste from the Southwest Compact.

In addition, I have also received information in a second email dated March 17, 2017 providing the volume and curies to be presently disposed at the Compact Waste Facility in Andrews, Texas. According to the email, PG&E Diablo Canyon will dispose of on has disposed of 63 curies (of 250 curies allowed) and 95 cubic feet (of 190 cubic feet allowed). This leaves 187 curies and 95 cubic feet remaining to be disposed under amended Agreement TLLRWDCC #2-0134-00.
