**TEXAS LOW-LEVEL RADIOACTIVE WASTE DISPOSAL COMPACT COMMISSION**

**Order Authorizing the Export of Waste**

**Entergy Nuclear – Vermont Yankee**

On or about May 21, 2018, the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Compact Commission (“TLLRWDC” or “Commission”) received from **Entergy Nuclear Vermont Yankee** a Petition to Export Class A waste described as 1) low dose rate, high density waste – approximately 1200 cubic feet of contaminated equipment/metals. 2) low dose rate, low density waste – approximately 3600 cubic feet of rags, mop heads, herculite, plastic, and contaminated protective clothing. Treatment proposed at the Energy Solutions Bear Creek facility near Oak Ridge, Tennessee. The Petition was filed pursuant to section 3.05(7) of the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Compact authorizing consideration of such export petitions.

At the Commission’s meeting posted for and held on July 12, 2018, a majority of the members of the Commission voted to approve the Petition filed by **Entergy Nuclear Vermont Yankee**, on the terms stated in the Petition, subject only to the following terms and conditions:

1. **Entergy Nuclear Vermont Yankee** will supply to the Commission:
  - a. Manifests and /or reports of the volume, mass, and activity sent for ultimate disposal which are satisfactory to the Commission.
  - b. Final reconciliation of waste volume concluded not later than 60 days post Order period.
2. The Period of the shipment of waste from the site of generation is authorized as effective from September 1, 2018 through August 31, 2019.

It is hereby ordered that **Entergy Nuclear Vermont Yankee** is authorized to export low-level radioactive waste as requested in the Petition, subject only to the terms and conditions as stated in this Order.
