The U.S. Army Joint Munitions Command, Rock Island, IL, requests an amendment to our previously approved import application (1-0188-00) for disposal of depleted uranium projectiles from demilitarized munitions. Due to increased production rates, we plan to increase the amount of waste shipped to Waste Control Specialists from 20,000 cubic feet (250 curies) to 35,000 cubic feet (440 curies) by August 31, 2019.

We request action from the Texas Low-Level Compact Commission at the next available commission meeting.
