

The Commission received a request on January 10, 2019 to amend Agreement #1-0188-00, Article II.J. (a) and (b) to increase the volume from 20,000 cubic feet to 35,000 cubic feet and the activity from 250 Curies to 440 Curies. After an affirmative vote by the Commission on February 28, 2019, the amendment is granted. Therefore, Article II.J. (a) and (b) are amended to read as follows:
