The export petition will allow STP the flexibility to export waste due to some unforeseen event where, for example, WCS is not able to fulfill its responsibility; the facility is not available due to some natural disaster; or the State of Texas has implemented contingency plans for the disposal and management of low-level radioactive waste that result in the compact facility</p>

being closed.

Additionally, STP has some legacy waste that may require special quotes from vendors prior to disposal or may have waste streams that WCS is not able to accept.
